



CORONA VIRUS SCHOOL UPDATE

- 1 IF YOU ARE CONCERNED THAT YOUR CHILD HAS THE SYMPTOMS OF CORONA VIRUS, (NEW PERSISTENT COUGH / HIGH TEMPERATURE) YOU THE PARENT, WILL MAKE THE DECISION TO KEEP YOUR CHILD OFF SCHOOL FOR SEVEN DAYS. SCHOOL STAFF ARE NOT QUALIFIED AND WILL NOT MAKE A DECISION ON A CHILD'S ABSENCE ON YOUR BEHALF.
- 2 SCHOOL IS REMAINING OPEN UNLESS WE ARE INSTRUCTED OTHERWISE AND WE WILL NOTIFY YOU SHOULD THE GOVERNMENT'S POSITION CHANGE.
- 3 YOUR CHILDREN ARE REMINDED TO REGULARLY WASH THEIR HANDS FOR TWENTY SECONDS WHICH THEY MUST DO THROUGHOUT THE DAY.
- 4 SCHOOL WILL BE CANCELLING THE PROPOSED VISIT TO CHESTER ZOO 2nd April 2020.
- 5 MR LOFTUS WILL MEET WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITY, PUBLIC HEALTH AND COLLEAGUE SEFTON HEADTEACHERS ON MONDAY AFTERNOON TO DISCUSS THIS ISSUE.
- 6 ONE OF THE MOST STRIKING STATEMENTS WHICH HAS BEEN MADE IN RELATION TO THE GOVERNMENT'S STRATEGY IS THAT THE RELATIVE SUCCESS OF MANAGING THIS PANDEMIC RELIES ON ALL OF US TAKING RESPONSIBILITY AND BEING PROACTIVE IN LIMITING THE IMPACT OF THIS DISEASE.
- 7 IN THE MEANTIME, THE SCHOOL CONTINUES ITS ACTIVITIES AND FOCUS ON CHILDREN'S EDUCATION AND AIMS TO MAINTAIN A **CALM AND SETTLED** ENVIRONMENT FOR **CHILDREN** AMIDST MANY CHALLENGES FOR GROWN UPS IN THE COMING WEEKS AND MONTHS.
